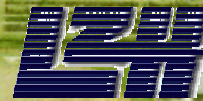

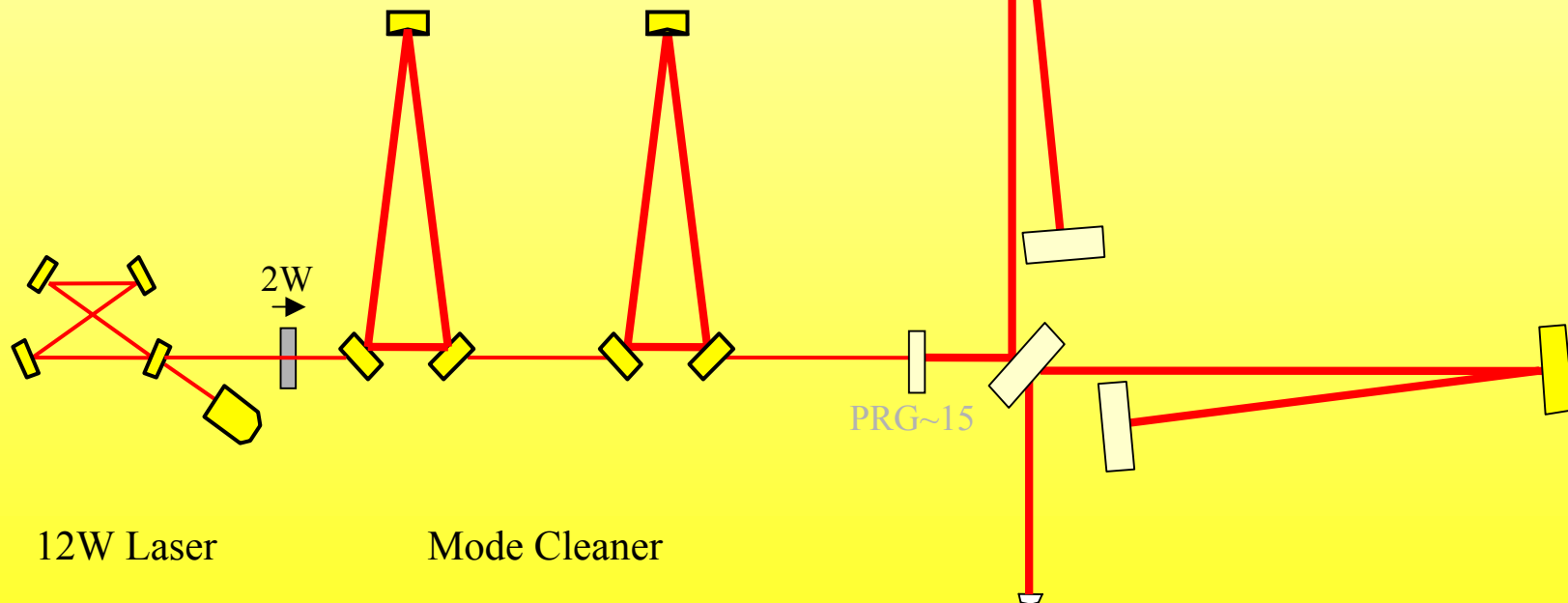
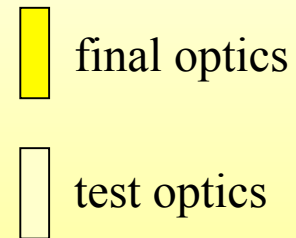

Slave laser, MC1, MC2

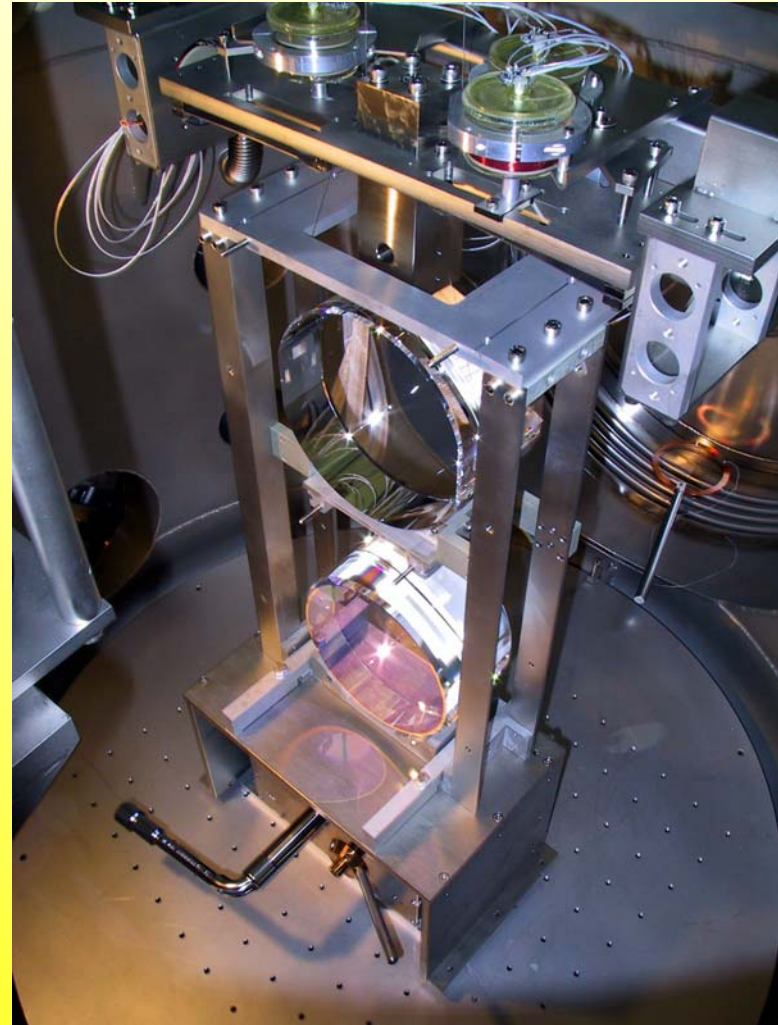
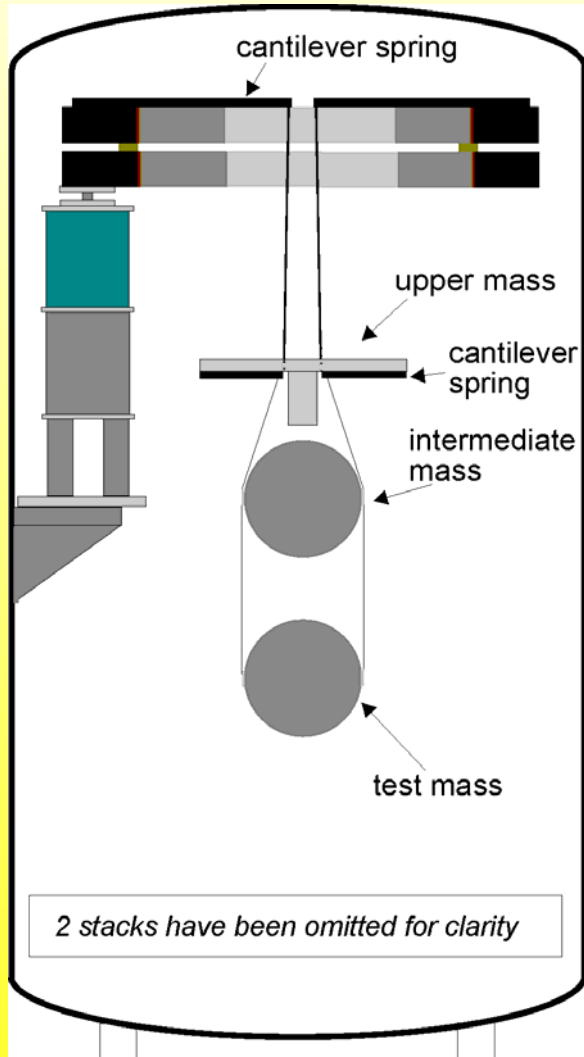
MC2 @ $f < 10\text{Hz}$ onto master laser piezo

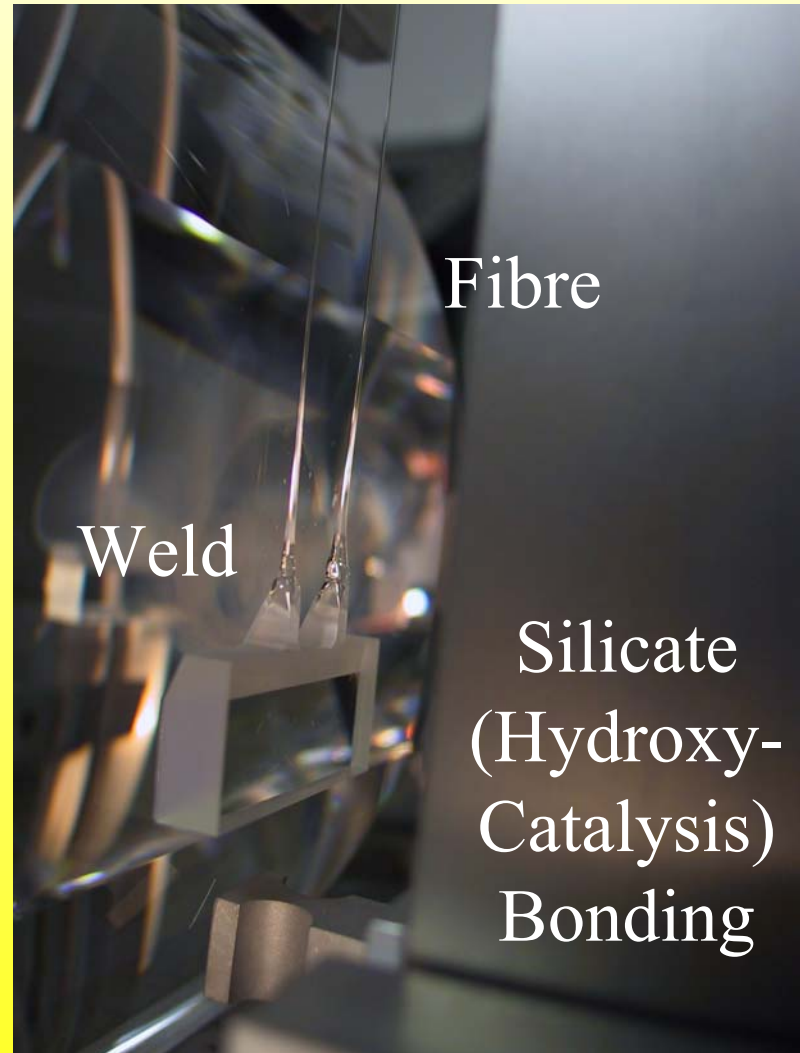
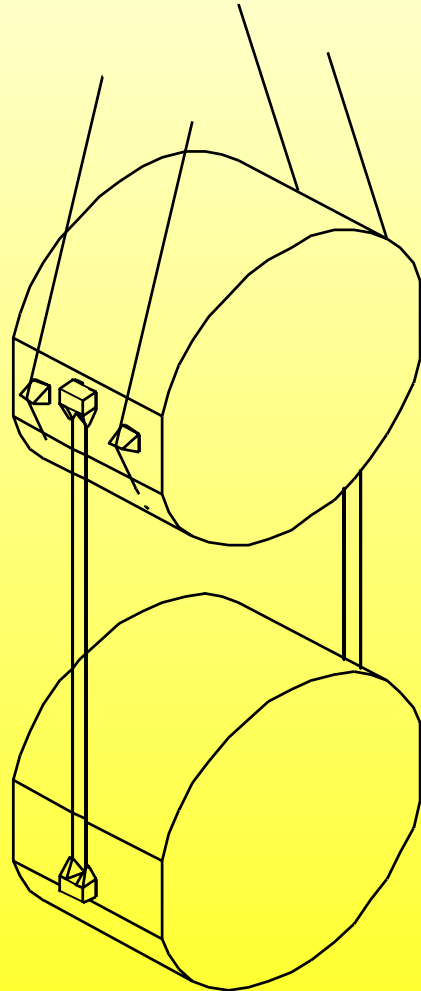
Michelson (DC-lock off after 3s, 500ms)

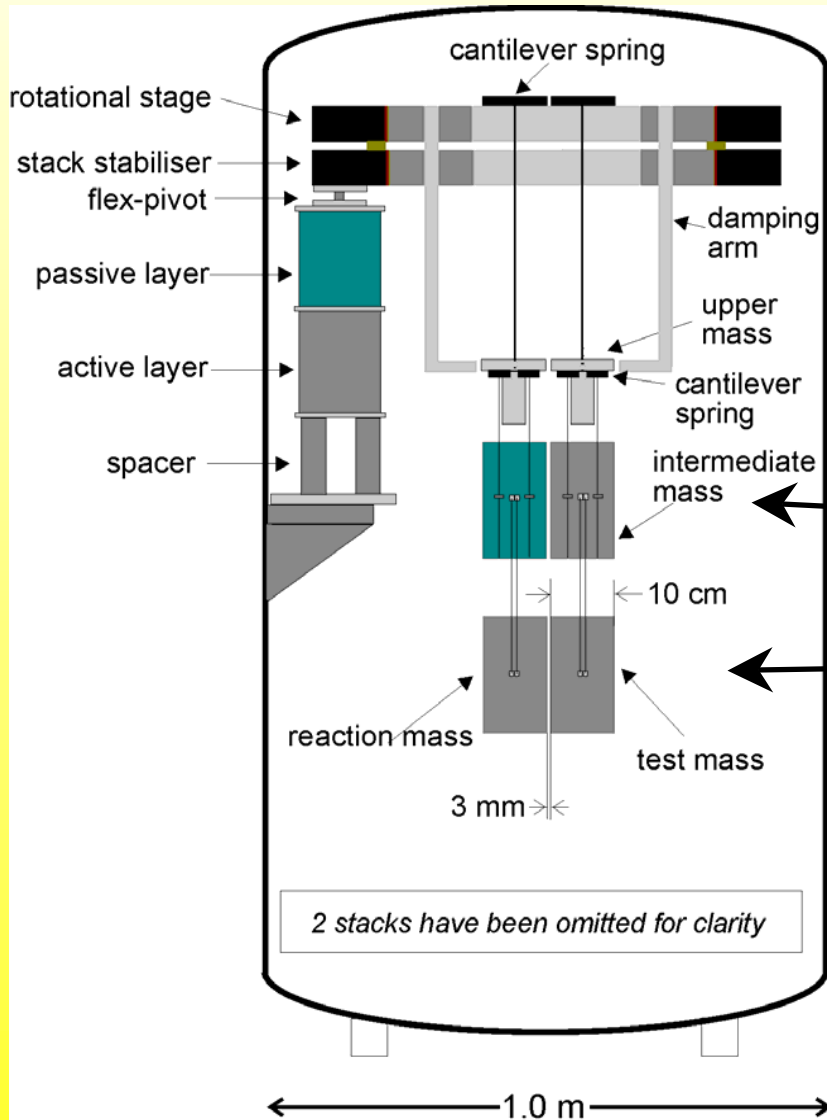

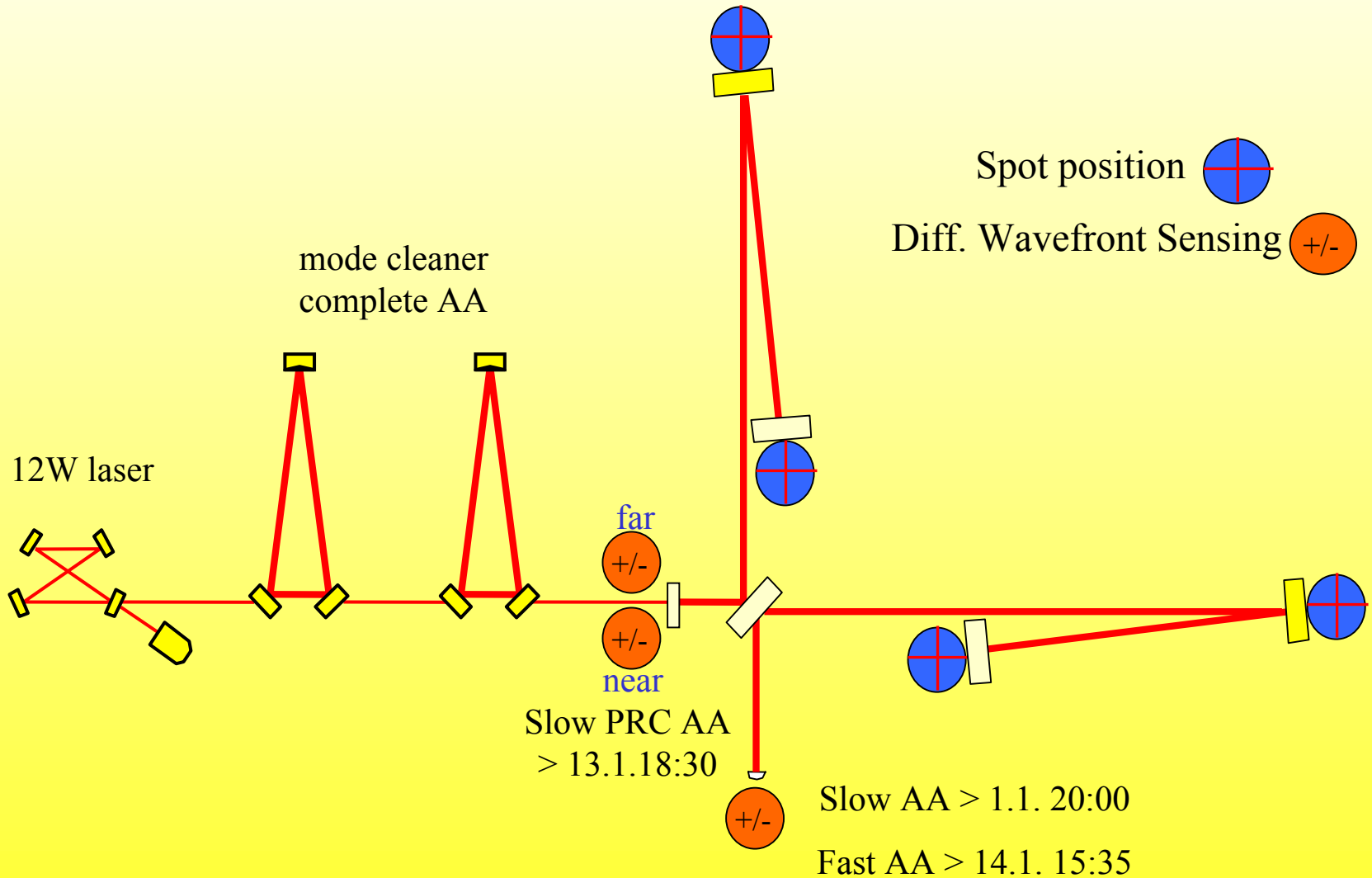

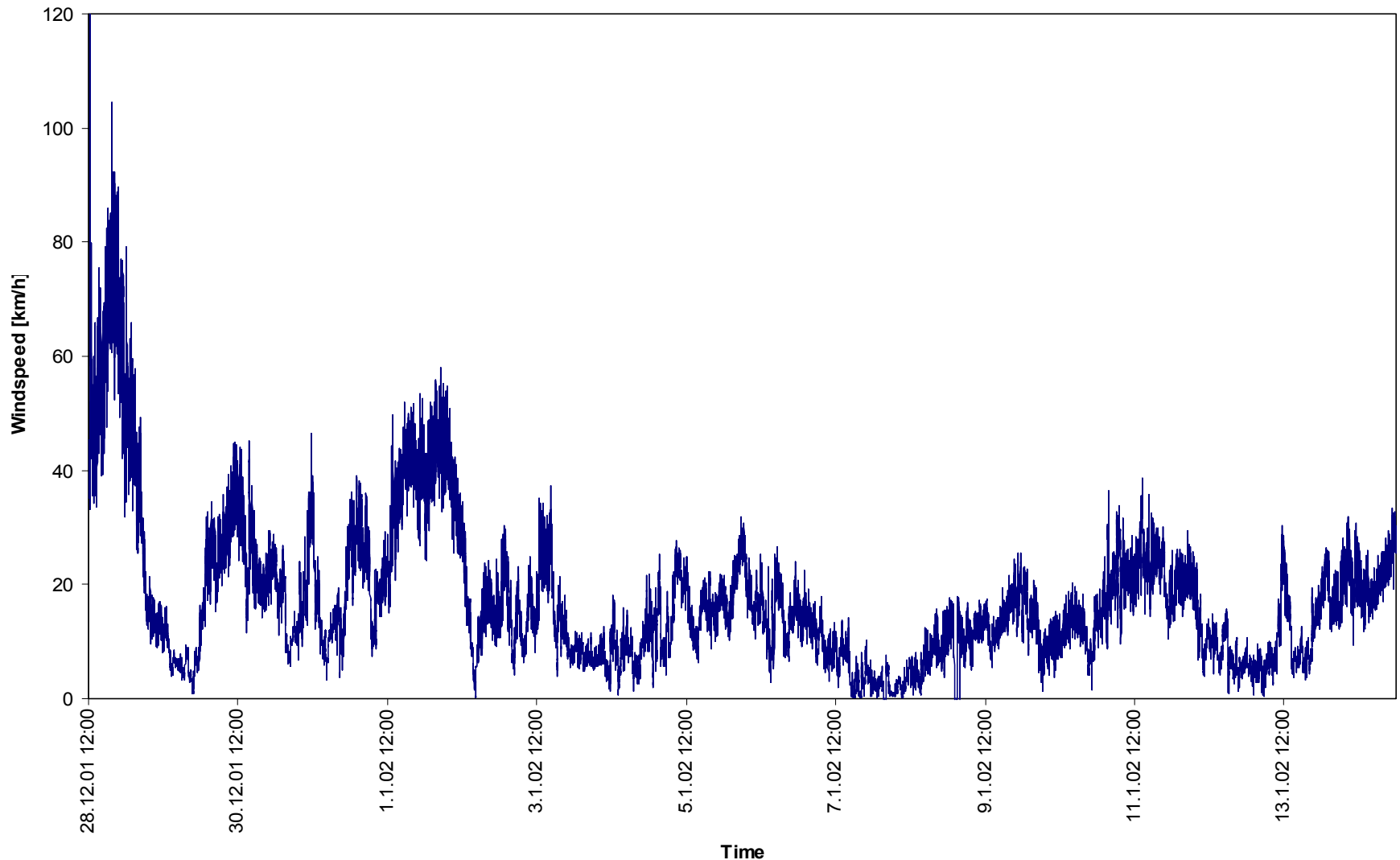

Coincidence Test Run: Duty Cycle



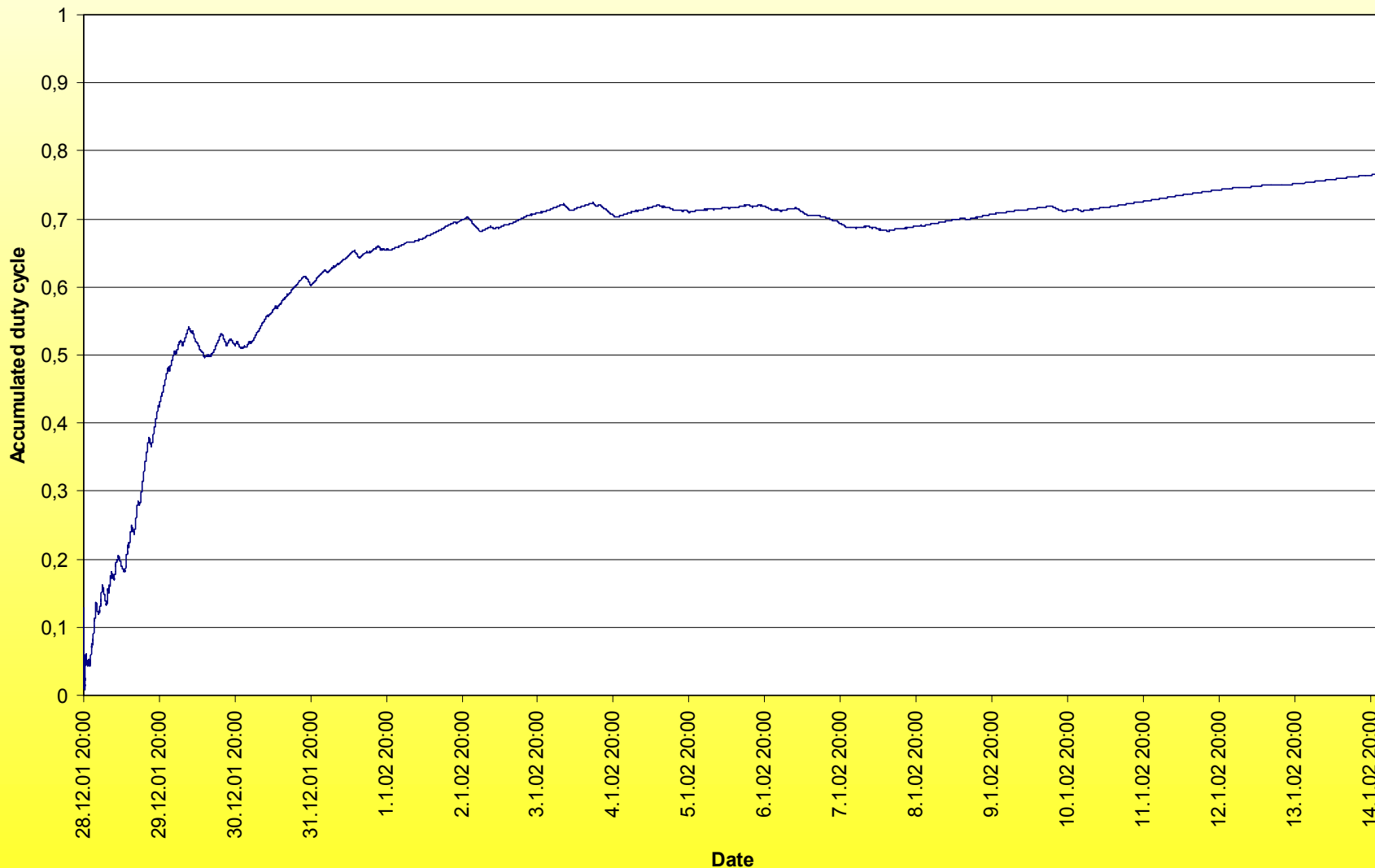
Windspeed during test-run

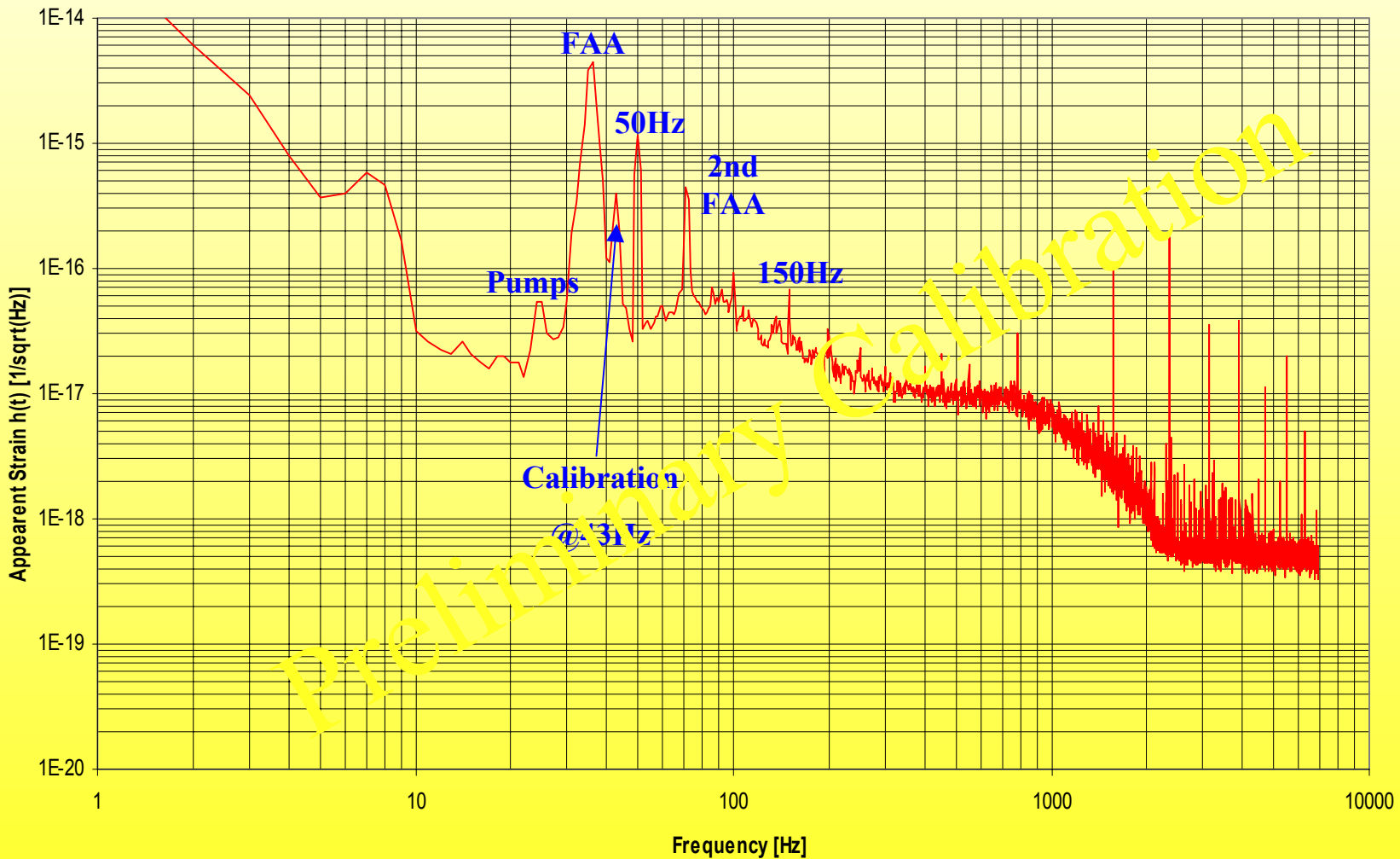
overall duty cycle (no maintenance periods subtracted)
